The commencement ceremony is held on the Saturday following the end of Spring term. Students who have not completed all of the degree requirements will be permitted to participate in the commencement ceremony under Antioch College's "walker" policy.

The petition must present a detailed, realistic plan for completion of the degree, have the signatures of all faculty members involved in the plan and the student's academic advisor, and be submitted to the Registrar **before the end of the seventh week of Spring term**.

The student must be able to complete the remaining work within the JA block, Fall, and ND block terms following Spring graduation. No more than **8 credits from any and all academic sources**, including all Antioch courses, transfer courses, consortia offerings, etc **or 12 credits from a single cooperative education experience**.

The plan for completing the outstanding work must demonstrate that the work will be finished within the JA block, Fall, and ND block terms following Spring graduation. Students completing work in the Fall will have a graduation date effective at the end of the calendar year.

- Students who are granted a reduced course load because of a documented disability may petition APRC for an exception to this walker policy.
- Students are permitted to participate in only one graduation ceremony. A student who walks in one year's ceremony but does not complete all graduation requirements by the end of the calendar year will not be permitted to walk in the next year's ceremony.
- Any student who will not be able to meet all the requirements for graduation as stated in this policy or the conditions for being a walker will not be considered for graduation until the following year.
