Holiday greetings from the Student Affairs team! Things are pretty quiet on campus right now, as the majority of students are gone for the break. However, we are working hard to prepare for the Winter and we can't wait for you to join in community with us!

In your new student portal, you will find a number of forms to complete before your arrival. Please make sure to get those done asap - especially the Housing Preferences Survey. We will use that to assign you to a living community! You can also stay on track with what should be happening each week by checking out the Pre-Orientation Schedule below.



<u>Residence Life:</u> This week, we wanted to provide some information to learn more about living on campus and prepare for your arrival to Antioch College.

- 1. Room Assignment: You will receive an individual email to your Antioch account from Residence Life with your room assignment and a move-in survey to indicate your plans for the arrival. If you need to make arrangements for travel from an airport, this is where you can make that request.
- 2. **Virtual Residence Hall Tours:** We've created <u>virtual tours of both North and Birch</u> residence halls so you can visualize what your room might look like.
- 3. **Packing list:** As you prepare to pack, please make sure to reference our <u>Packing List</u> we offer suggestions as well as reminders about items allowed/not allowed.
- 4. **Resident Assistants (RAs):** You can also find information about your Resident Assistant team (RAs) online along with <u>planning dates and information</u> regarding Residence Life.

On-Campus meals and amenities: Another major piece of living on campus is food. As part of room and board, all residential students have access to the Antioch Kitchen in Birch Hall. Hot meals are served three times a day, Monday through Friday, and twice a day (brunch and dinner) Saturday and Sunday. Every meal has a vegetarian and vegan option and there is always a salad bar available. For more information on the Antioch Kitchen, visit here. Part of our produce and eggs come from The Antioch Farm and we are very proud of our farm to table process! If you'd like to learn more, you can watch a video about The Antioch Farm. In addition, Birch Hall has shared, full kitchens including fridges, microwaves, stoves, and ovens for your use. In North Hall, the first floor has a microwave and communal fridge, as well as kitchenettes on each floor. You can learn and see more about these in the virtual tours for each residence hall mentioned above.

<u>Student Support:</u> Here on campus, we aim to provide supports for the academic, community, and personal wellness aspects of your time here.

1. **Academic Support:** During your time at Antioch, you may find use in utilizing one of our academic support systems, such as peer tutoring, student success events, or through meeting with our Student Success Coordinator. For more information about these

- 2. Community Support: Entering a new community can come with a set of unique challenges, and although the experience of entering college brings a lot of opportunities for personal growth, it is also important to acknowledge the potential for obstacles. Luckily, there are supports in place to help you navigate this exciting transition. Our Residence Life team, including professional staff and our fantastic team of RAs, are available to help you throughout your Antioch experience. Members of this team are the perfect first-step to reach out to when you need to be connected to campus resources, but aren't exactly sure who to reach out to or how to receive support.
- 3. Personal Wellness: We have many programs that seek to provide support through difficult times and help students flourish. Our medical services and counseling services staff are located in Pennell House and offer inclusive and holistic ways to heal and grow. As well, we have our spectacular Wellness Center full of various amenities and activities for students to prioritize their wellness. In this changing weather, my personal favorite is the indoor pool and hot tub!

<u>Accommodations:</u> At Antioch, accommodations are generally divided into two categories, academic accommodations, which are done with the goal of making the classroom an accessible space through addressing specific student needs, or housing accommodations, which are made for ensuring students can be safe, comfortable, and successful in the campus living environment. This includes requests for emotional support animals (ESAs). If you filled out a disability self-disclosure form, you may have already been in contact with <u>Jamin Kollasch</u>, our Student Success Services Coordinator. Student Billing/Accounts and Financial Aid: On campus, there are two main folks you'll be working with when it comes to finances. The first, who you have already heard from throughout your application process, is Matthew Dec. Matthew is our Director of Financial Aid, and is the person to talk to for questions about your scholarship, overall costs, and loan distribution.
